All instruction is provided by veterinarians and experts from world renowned facilities who are currently practicing in the field of aquatic animal and conservation medicine. Emphasis is placed on physical examination, hematology, basic aquatic animal internal medicine, necropsy techniques and rehabilitation strategies.
